

LOCKERLY ARBORETUM'S Camp Oliver Worley - 2010 Eatonton, Georgia

Camp Sessions: Two (2) one-week sessions based on grade level.

Cost: The \$50.00 supply fee covers all expenses necessary.

Space: Limited to 12 students per session. There will be a 6:1 student/staff ratio.

Camp Hours: 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

- Early drop off – 7:30 a.m.
- Late pick up: please, no later than **5:45 p.m.**

Camp Description: We will be outside 90% of the time. Campers should be interested in science and the outdoors and will participate in hands-on, science-based activities. The Worley Nature Center is an excellent area for exploring wetland habitat. We will study primitive skills and folklore important to settlers of our region.

Camp Sessions (2):

Session I	June 21 - 25 3 rd – 5 th graders
Session II	July 12 - 16 6 th – 9 th graders

Directions:

From Milledgeville: Take 441 north toward Eatonton. Pass Bugaloo Salvage on left and look for a railroad crossing. Turn **right** onto Park Road directly before the tracks. Follow Park Road for 0.8 miles and look for the Worley Environmental Education Center on the left. If you reach the bridge, you have gone too far.

From Eatonton: From Gray Highway intersection (Dairy Queen and BP station, bypass), travel 1.2 miles on 441 south toward Milledgeville. Cross the railroad tracks and make an almost immediate **left** onto Park Road. Follow Park Road for 0.8 miles and look for the Worley Environmental Education Center on the left. If you reach the bridge, you have gone too far.
